Web Innovations and Technology Services (WITS), a non-for-profit organization, and the City of Clayton are sponsoring the sixth annual electronic recycling event on Friday, March 19, 2010 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Saturday, March 20, 2010 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. The event is open to residents of Clayton and businesses in the Clayton area and surrounding cities. Last year WITS collected two tractor trailers full of electronic equipment of about 35 tons for a total of over 100 tons since 2005. The event will be held in the south parking lot of Shaw Park. WITS will pick up electronics for free from businesses that complete the participation form and have 15 or more bulky items, otherwise they will pick up electronics for a \$20 pickup fee. Forms should be returned to WITS no later than 5 p.m. on Friday, March 12th. Business recycling will be the focus of the event on Friday with Saturday will be more for residents.

Here is the list of materials we accept:

- Computers, laptops, monitors, printers, cables and peripherals (keyboards and mice, etc.)
- Office equipment, business equipment and machinery including most furniture and operations equipment
- Networking equipment, server, telecommunications, phones, clocks, etc.
- TVs up to 24" (\$10 fee), 24"- 40" (\$15) and console and big screen (\$20), VCR, stereos and similar audio and video equipment including cable/satellite
- Home electronics, blenders, toasters, irons, etc. and most home furniture (please call)
- White goods: washers, dryers, dishwashers, microwaves, furnaces, etc.
- Medical equipment and all types diagnostic equipment
- Electrical, cabling and communication machinery and equipment
- Industrial machinery and equipment including power and gas equipment
- Lawn equipment, tools, old mowers, tillers, etc.
- Air conditioners, refrigerators, humidifiers and other Freon containing devices
- Old motors, transformers and other electrical equipment.
- Car and lead-containing batteries and items
- CD's, VHS, DVD, cassettes, DAT and all type of data tapes



Directions to the Collection Site:

- Brentwood to Shaw Park Dr./Forest Park Parkway, turn West as if you were going toward I-170. DO NOT get onto Forest Park Parkway. Stay right on the onramp, this will still be Shaw Park Drive. You should see Shaw Park on your right.
- The collection area will be at the bottom of the hill.
